

**Sala Kryszek Art & Writing Competition**  
**2018 WRITING GUIDELINES**

**Deadline: Monday, April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018**

A full range of writing formats are permissible including essay, poetry, play, short story, and letter.

- Entries must address the prompt and make a clear connection to Holocaust history.
- Student's name may **not** appear on any copies of writing submissions, and **MUST** appear on both the Registration Form and Release Form.
- Entries must be titled, and the title must appear on each copy of the submission.
- Entries must be formatted with black type, be double-spaced, be written in 12 point Times New Roman font, and include margins of 1" on the top, bottom, left, and right.
- All entries must be submitted via email as both a Word document and a PDF file to **education@ojmche.org** with the subject line: **Student Name: 2018 Sala Kryszek Art and Writing Competition.**
- If email is unavailable, submissions may be printed on paper and mailed to OJMCHC at the address below. Mailed entries must include one original copy of the entry with the Registration Form and Release Form attached, plus three (3) additional copies of the submission, each stapled separately. If a mailed entry is selected as a winner in the competition, a digital copy of the piece will be requested immediately.
- Entries may not exceed 1,500 words.
- OJMCHC reserves the right to publish all submitted works. Any submission that does not have accompanying Registration and Release Forms (scanned or mailed) will be automatically disqualified.
- All entries must be the original work of the student.
- **Entries must be received by OJMCHC by April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018.**
- Entries will not be returned to students.
- Writing entries are limited to one entry per student. Students may also submit one entry to the art category.
- Grand Prize winners will be asked to write a letter of thanks to the Kryszek family detailing their visit to the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum in Washington, D.C. upon their return.
- Grand Prize and First Place winners will be asked to speak briefly about their work at the award ceremony on **Sunday, May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018.**

**Entries that do not address the prompt or meet the above guidelines will automatically be disqualified.**

Winners will be notified on April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
